### **USE OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**

Cell phones, beepers, and personal audio and visual equipment may not be used during school hours. Students using these items during the school day are subject to school discipline and the items may be confiscated. If a student is using an electronic device and does not comply with a teacher's request to put it away or surrender it, the teacher should refer the student to the office for discipline.

In most cases, confiscated electronic equipment will be returned to the student at the end of the school day. In the case of continued infractions, confiscated equipment will be returned to parents/guardians after a meeting. Students are hereby reminded that the Holbrook Public Schools and its staff are not responsible if items that a student brings to school are lost, stolen, or damaged.
