STUDENT SAFETY

Proper attention will be paid to the safety of pupils on school property during the normal school day, during their participation in school sponsored extracurricular activities on school grounds, and at school functions scheduled away from school property.

The Superintendent or designee is responsible for developing a district-wide program that emphasizes safety of pupils on school property during the normal school day, at school district sponsored extracurricular activities on school property, and at school functions scheduled away from school property.

The Superintendent or designee will also work with state and town officials to develop traffic plans and other appropriate plans that emphasize student safety.

The Committee recognizes that it is the parents' responsibility to supervise students on their way to and from school, with the exception of students who ride to school on district-provided transportation. Students riding to school on district-provided transportation will be subject to the rules and regulations developed for their safety. (See Policy JICC and Policy EEAEC).

It is the responsibility of the principal and teachers to arrange for adequate supervision of students on school property during the normal school day, as well as at extracurricular activities sponsored by the School District on school property, and school sponsored functions held off school property. Special attention should be given to the prevention of accidents and to the development of habits of good citizenship.

Students shall be taught safe practices in such subject areas as technology education, physical education, health, and laboratory courses in science as well as in extracurricular athletic activities.
