School Choice Policies

Fully completed applications will be reviewed daily based on the number of seats allocated by grade as follows:

- Kindergarten (Not Offered)
- Grade 1-8 (Closed)
- Grades 9-11 *(Open)
- Grade 12 (Not Offered)

School Choice Process

The application process is an open enrollment First Come-First Serve process. **ONLY COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WILL BE REVIEWED.** Selection will be free from any type of discrimination. **APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER JUNE 1, 2018.**

Yearly Application Process

Once a non-resident student has been admitted under the School Choice program, the student has the right to remain in that district until graduation from high school unless there is a lack of funding of the program. This right exists even if the school district decides that it will no longer participate in the School Choice program.

School Choice Transportation

Transportation for School Choice students is to be provided by their parents/guardians.
